**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION**

**1**

The Pescaraabruzzo Foundation announces the eighth edition of the “**Pescarabruzzo Foundation NordSud International Prize for Literature and Science**” established with the aim to encourage dialogue between the North and the South of the World.

**2**

2.1 Participants to the Prize can only apply on recommendation from publishing houses, institutions, organizations, universities, cultural associations, personalities and other national and international organizations. Their works should be addressed to: Segreteria del Premio presso la Fondazione Pescaraabruzzo, Corso Umberto I n. 83, 65122 Pescara. All applicants must send eight copies of their work accompanied by a letter of participation with their personal data (address, telephone and e-mail). The deadline for submission is **August 1<sup>st</sup> 2016** (postmark will attest date of application).

2.2 In accordance with paragraph 2.1 above, the Jury can also decide to consider works other than those received.

**3**

The award is divided into three sections:

**a) POETRY**

**b) SOCIAL SCIENCES**

Applicants can compete for both Poetry and Narrative sections with works published in Italy in the last three years preceding the date of publication of this announcement. With regard to the Science section, the Jury will retain the right to award the Prize. The winners of each section will be awarded a prize of € 4,000.00 (four thousand euros).

Participation in the competition implies full acceptance and understanding of these rules. The awards will be conferred in Pescara between October and November 2016 (date to be specified).

**5**

The Jury is composed by Nicola Mattoscio (President), Stevka Šmitran (Secretary) and by five members that will take turns: Franco Cardini, Francesco Marroni, Elio Pecora, Benito Sablone and Lucia Votano.

For 2016 the Jury consists of: Nicola Mattoscio (President) Stevka Šmitran (Secretary), Francesco Marroni, Elio Pecora.

Winners must be present at the awards ceremony. They must also submit a speech to the Jury by **September 30<sup>th</sup> 2016**. The speech should express the author's idea of contemporaneity, according to his/her respective section (poetry, fiction and science). Should a candidate be absent, or should he fail to send his/her speech, he/she will be considered as having renounced.

The Secretariat will inform the winner about the Jury's decision at least a month before the date set for the Prize award ceremony.

All works submitted will not be returned. The Jury is not compelled to disclose the titles of the works or the authors excluded from the ceremony.

Matters not covered by this announcement shall be subject to the Jury's incontestable decisions.
